

Classroom Cabin Passes Inspection

Pauline Martin, Former Head Teacher of the C of E School in South Kilworth contacted Rural Log Cabins in October 2009, after seeing one of the cabins in use at the St Marys Montessori Nursery in Lutterworth. This was built by Rural Log Cabins back in 2003.

Pauline liked the idea of an alternative solution for additional classroom space that was bespoke designed to cater for the school's present and potential future needs.

The layout and a price for the cabin were agreed, and then the order was confirmed. In December 2009 the planning application was prepared and sent off for approval. After a two month delay the planning was approved in April 2010.

On site work commenced from May 2010, the construction process itself was conducted entirely onsite and during the school's normal operating hours and included: site clearance, excavation, onsite manufacture and installation of the super structure, electrics, plumbing, sewage connection, IT services, decking, staining & varnishing.

Final components to be installed also included: air-conditioning, landscaping, alterations to the existing wrought iron fencing, brickwork planters, alarms, smoke detectors, digital data lock

to the access doors, vinyl flooring, carpets and roller blinds. As well as BRUKL calculations and a building regulations certificate.

Pauline Martin, Former Head Teacher liked the fact that Rural Log Cabins provided a package. *"The project was taken out of my hands so I could concentrate on the school. I was amazed by the smooth running of the whole project; we hardly knew they were even there."*
